- Read all warnings and precautions carefully and follow safety procedures
- Each Seizmik product has a "difficulty-to-install" rating based on the following:
 - Easy uses basic hand tools and does not require any modifications to the existing structure of your vehicle. Most Seizmik products fall into this category. Hey, why be difficult?
 - Skilled requires a little more skill to install properly. May require modifications to the vehicle (drilling, electrical, etc. as well as the use of power tools.
 - Difficult May require welding or extensive mechanical work for proper installation. Hardly any Seizmik products fall into this category but we had to say it.




RTV 900 Dust Panel Installation (continued)



1. Wrap the velcro around the rear top bar on the roll cage. Ensure that the end flaps are secured around the bar as shown in the pictures.



2. Allow the bottom end of the back panel to drape behind the dump bed.



3. Locate the straps running down the length of the rear vertical ROPS bar. Fasten around the bar. Repeat this step for the opposite side.

Tip – A good way to get the straps tight is to rotate the top around the bar like in the picture on the right.



4. Locate the strap on the driver side at rear of the cab. Fasten around the bar as shown below.

5. Locate the strap on the passenger side with the adhesive velcro strip. Clean the plastic panel on the vehicle with alcohol, remove the strip and secure to plastic panel as shown.

Rolling up the Dust Panel



A - The rear window can be rolled up by undoing step 3, rolling the window up from the bottom, and securing with the three straps at the top of the window as shown.
